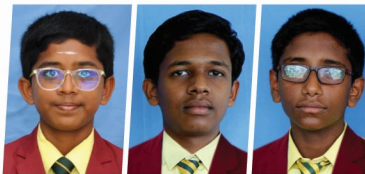
## DRAWING COMPETITION BY POWERGRID

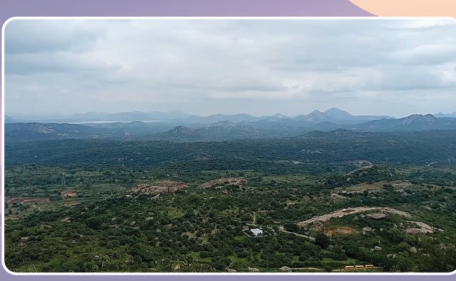

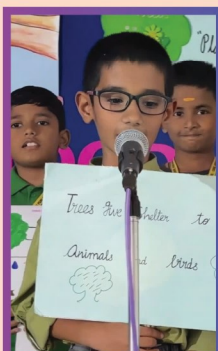

This hands-on art and craft experience allowed the children to actively engage with the letter sound and shape.



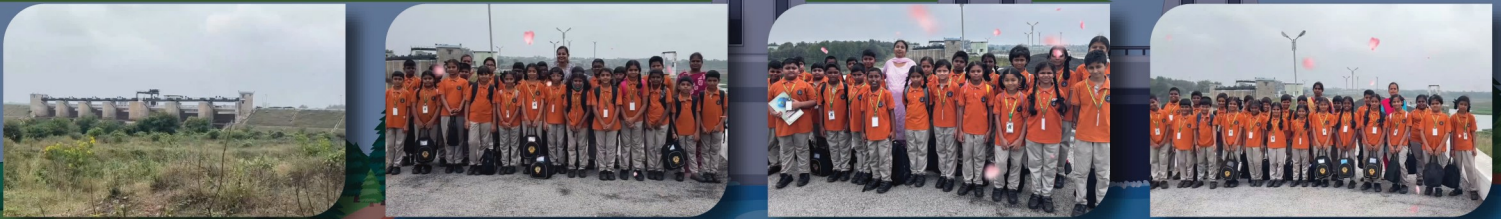
## JOLLYPHONICS ACTIVITY PAPER TEARING AND PASTING
